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Eclat

“Eclat” was inspired by similar gem-like chandeliers of the 1920s especially those made by the renowned Bagues in this period. Eclat, meaning to sparkle or shine, does just that; The wrought iron frame is gilded in real silver or gold leaf or can be a warm bronze patina. The cut lead crystal flowers and stylised leaves can also be specified in various colours. Cox London has produced similar chandeliers to suit specific spaces and supply a full design and service.

Each metal component is cut lathed and shaped to construct the frame of the chandelier, which is then gilded and distressed. Different sized cut crystal leaves are applied on single stems and back lit by reflective gilt metal. Flowers and buds of hand woven, cut crystal drops are arranged in a bouquet springing from the central crystal urn.
